

1 Hybrid Model

Students spend two days per week on campus (T/TH), receiving professional instruction in all core subjects and fine arts. The other days of the week, students study at home under the supervision of a parent, using the SJVA grade appropriate syllabus as a guide.

On Wednesdays, we offer supplemental tutoring and enrichment classes in the afternoons, such as Irish Dance and Fun with French.
